DESCRIPTION: He was a schoolboy, a Torres Strait Islander.

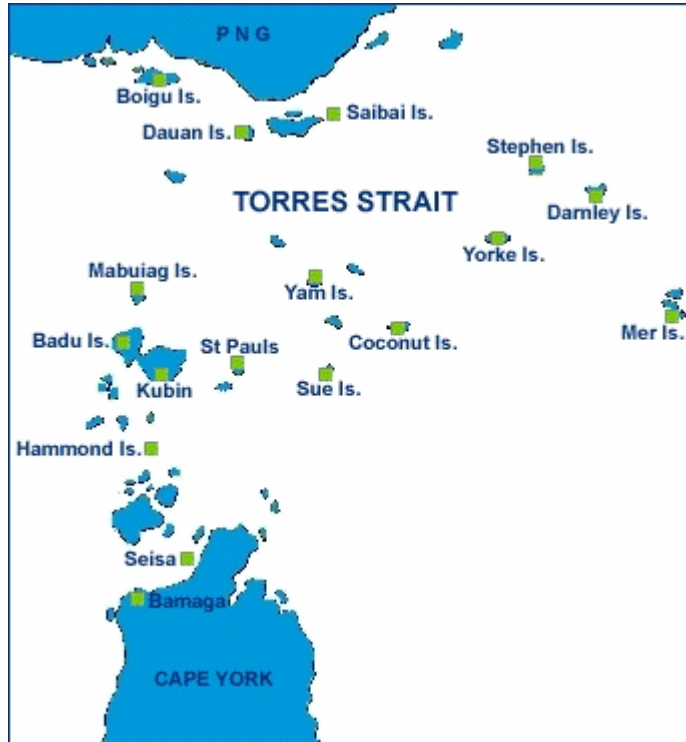
BACKGROUND
