Sydney, Monday.— A shocking tragedy occurred at Sydney last night when falling from a launch in Sailor Bay, Middle Harbour, Frank Kenny of Mosman, is believed to have been taken by a huge shark within the view of a number of horror-stricken companions. A swirl followed by an awesome phosphorescent glow in the water preceded the fearsome tragedy. Kenny uttered a stifled groan of despair and then disappeared.
