DATE: October 1988

LOCATION: The accident took place in the Gulf of Mexico at Sanibel Island, Lee County, Florida, USA.

NAME: Sally Jo Scott

DESCRIPTION: She is a 23-year-old female from Beaverton.

NARRATIVE: She apparently stepped on the shark.

INJURY: She sustained four lacerations to left leg.

TREATMENT: Her injury required 35 stitches.

SPECIES: Not identified.
