

ACTIVITY: Probable drowning and scavenging

DATE: June 12, 1981

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Pacific Ocean at Honoli'i Pali, Hilo Bay ('Alae Point), Hawai'i, USA.

NAME: Preston D. Soley

NARRATIVE: No details.

INJURY: Autopsy indicated death was probably due to drowning.

SPECIES: Not identified. Retrieval of the remains were hindered by a four-foot shark. At least four different sharks had fed on the body.
