

ACTIVITY: Rowing

CASE: GSAF 1984.03.10 / SA-325

DATE: March 10, 1984.

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Indian Ocean off the mouth of the Swartkops River, Eastern Cape Province, South Africa.



NAME: Louis Beyers

NARRATIVE: Louis Beyers was rowing with four other men from the Bluewater Bay Surf Life-saving Club. They were training for the South African Championships when a shark seized his oar, pulled it loose and disappeared with it.

INJURY: No injury to Mr. Beyers or any of the rowers

SPECIES: Not identified. The shark was said to be 2,5 metres in length.
