

ACTIVITY: Drowning and scavenging

CASE: [GSAF 1985.09.08.b](#) / SA-337

DATE: Sunday September 8, 1985

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Indian Ocean at T. O. Strand in Leisure Bay, some 175 kilometres south of Durban and 26 kilometres south of Margate on the coast of KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa.

NAME: Anthony Mzwendola

DESCRIPTION: He was a 21-year-old male.

BACKGROUND

ENVIRONMENT: T. O. Strand had (and still has) shark nets.

TIME: 16h00

NARRATIVE: The young man got into difficulties and drowned. Five days later his body was recovered at Port Edward; it had been scavenged by a shark/s.

SPECIES: Not identified.
