

**ACTIVITY:** Diving

**CASE:** GSAF 1986.04.00

**DATE:** April 1986

**LOCATION:** The incident took place in the Mediterranean Sea at Lloret de Mar, Catalonia, Spain.

41°41'N, 02°53'E

**BACKGROUND**

Lloret de Mar is one of the most popular holiday resorts on the Costa Brava. It is 40 kilometres from Girona and 75 kilometres from Barcelona.

**NARRATIVE:** Diver 'attacked' by a shark. His partner reported the shark made several attacks and they could not get rid of it, the shark eventually left but stayed in the area, the divers then decided to leave the water.

**INJURY:** Minor injury. The diver sustained scratches (abrasions) sustained when he hit the shark.

**SPECIES:** The incident involved a two-metre "dark shark with a small mouth"
