CASE: GSAF 1988.06.05

DATE: Sunday June 5, 1988

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean off 2400 S. Atlantic Avenue, Daytona Beach, Volusia County, Florida, USA.

INJURY: The boy sustained four deep lacerations to his ankle.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: Jason's parents and a lifeguard helped the boy from the water and his injury was treated in the emergency room at Halifax Medical Center in Daytona Beach.
