BACKGROUND

MOON PHASE: First Quarter, December 16, 1988 **ENVIRONMENT:** The Chilean coast has kelp beds in which divers seek large edible mollusks known locally as locos, *Concholepas concholepas*. Because locos have been heavily collected in shallower inshore waters, deeper diving became necessary. Chilean divers wear full wetsuits and often dive with a hookah. Most of them dive alone.

NARRATIVE: He was diving for locos when he was killed by the shark. His diving partners brought his body to shore.

INJURY: Fatal

SPECIES: The attack involved a white shark, 16 feet

in length.
