

ACTIVITY: Probable drowning and scavenging.

CASE: **GSF 1989.01.08**

DATE: Sunday January 8, 1989

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Pacific Ocean at Wailua, Kaua'i, Hawaii, USA.

NAME: Ken Ahlstrand

NARRATIVE: He was swimming in a strong current with three others when he disappeared.



A two-day search by helicopters, Civil Air Patrol and firemen failed to find any trace of the missing man. The lower part of his body was found six days later on January 14, 1989 near a seawall by the Wailua Golf Course. X-rays of the remains revealed teeth marks in the femur and tibia.

SPECIES: Not identified.
