

ACTIVITY: Scuba diving
CASE: GSAF 1989.09.03
DATE: Sunday 3 September 1986
LOCATION: The incident took place in the Pacific Ocean about 24 kilometres north of Catalina Island in the Channel Islands, California, USA.

NAME: Larry Stroup
DESCRIPTION: He is a 46-year-old male.

NARRATIVE: Larry Stroup was filming blue sharks. He had left the safety of the cage and was attempting to feed squid to one of the sharks when it bit his hand.

INJURY: The diver's hand and both arms were severely lacerated.

SPECIES: The incident involved a five-foot blue shark.
