**CASE:** GSAF 1990.04.01

**DATE:** Sunday April 1, 1990

**LOCATION:** The incident took place in the Pacific Ocean at a surf spot called Silva's channel in Mokuleia on the north shore of O'ahu, Hawaii, USA.

**NAME:** Everett Peacock

**DESCRIPTION:** Male

**BACKGROUND**

**MOON PHASE:** Waxing Crescent, 44% of the Moon was illuminated. First Quarter, April 2, 1990.

**ENVIRONMENT:** Mokuleia Beach, only 150 feet deep, stretches six miles and, in 1990, bordered some of the last undeveloped sections of shoreline on O'ahu.

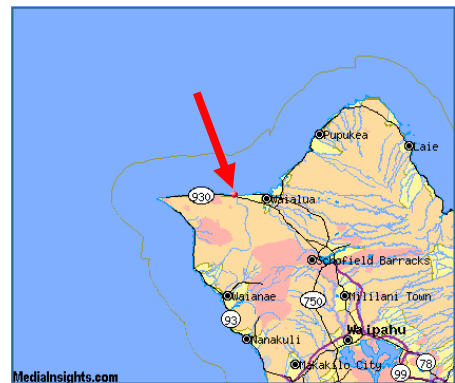
**SEA CONDITIONS:** The sea was murky.

**DISTANCE FROM SHORE:** 150 yards

**TIME:** 07h30

**NARRATIVE:** He was sitting on his surfboard when his left ankle was bitten.

**INJURY:** Lacerations to ankle and severe abrasions to lower left leg.
