MOON PHASE: First Quarter, October 27, 1990

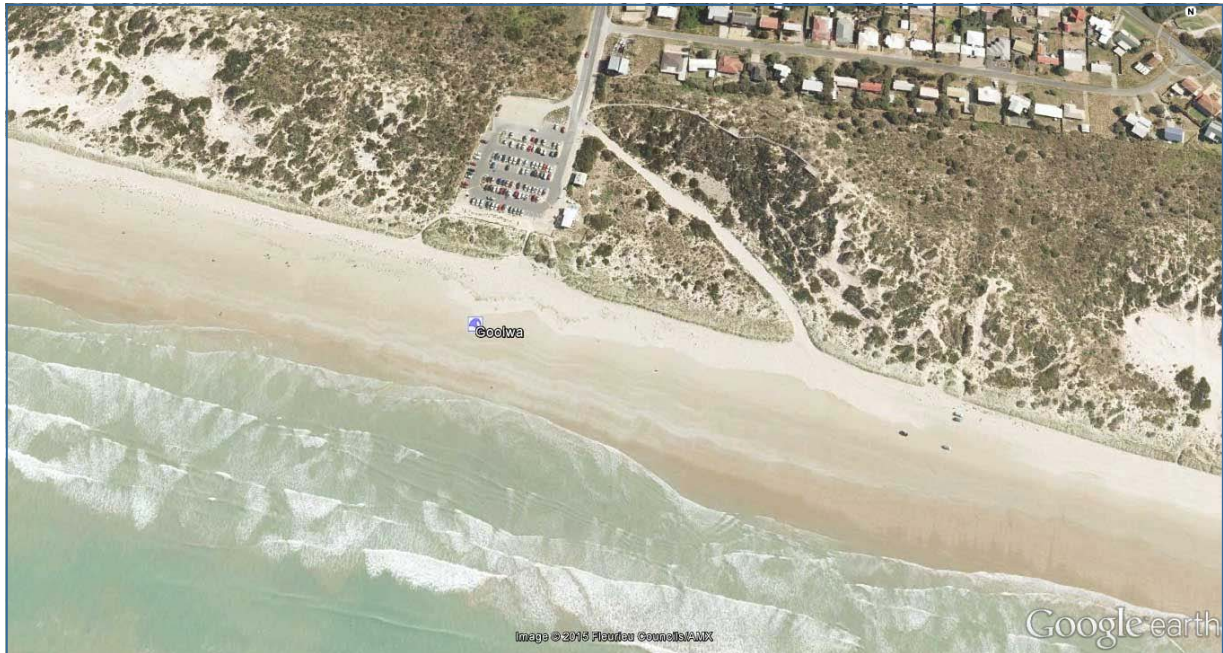
TIME: 10h30
