Fishermen search for killer shark

SAN SALVADOR, El Salvador (AP) — Fishermen hunted on Friday for a great white shark believed responsible for killing one teen-age surfer and injuring another off El Salvador's Pacific coast.

Authorities believe the same shark killed two oyster fishermen in an attack in August on a fishing boat.
