

**ACTIVITY:** Surfing

**DATE:** Friday July 28, 1995

**LOCATION:** The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean slightly south of Ponce de Leon Inlet, Volusia County, Florida, USA.

**NAME:** Unknown

**DESCRIPTION:** The surfer is a male.

### **BACKGROUND**

**MOON PHASE:** New Moon, July 27, 1995

**ENVIRONMENT:** Volusia County lifeguard, Captain Paul Pivec, said that some of the surfers reported seeing sharks (species unknown) that were about two feet in length.

**TIME:** 16h30

**NARRATIVE:** No details. This was the fourth shark bite at the inlet on the same day.

**INJURY:** His left foot was bitten.

**FIRST AID:** The surfer wrapped his wound and was taken away by relatives.
