**DATE:** Saturday May 31, 1997

**LOCATION:** The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean south of the municipal pier in the area of South 27th Street in Flagler Beach, Flagler County, Florida, USA.

**NAME:** Rob Fuller

**DESCRIPTION:** He is a 34-year-old male from Flagler Beach.

**INJURY:** There was a single wound on the surfer's left elbow.

**FIRST AID / TREATMENT:** The surfer drove to the hospital where he was treated and released.

**SPECIES INVOLVED:** Lifeguards thought the bite may have been caused by a sand shark because of the size of the bite.
