MOON PHASE: Full Moon, June 20, 1997

TIME: 23h00 (Night)



NARRATIVE: He was spearfishing at night and had a fish stringer on his left side. He saw the shark just before contact.

INJURY: The diver was bitten on his left leg just above his ankle.

SPECIES: According to the diver, the shark was 2.4 metres [eight feet] in length.
