

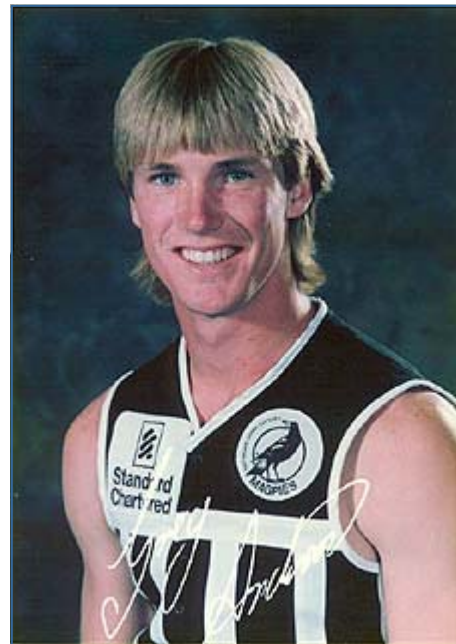


ACTIVITY: Surfing

NAME: Greg Anderson
