DESCRIPTION: He is a 22-year-old white male from Casselbury. He was wearing a bathing suit.

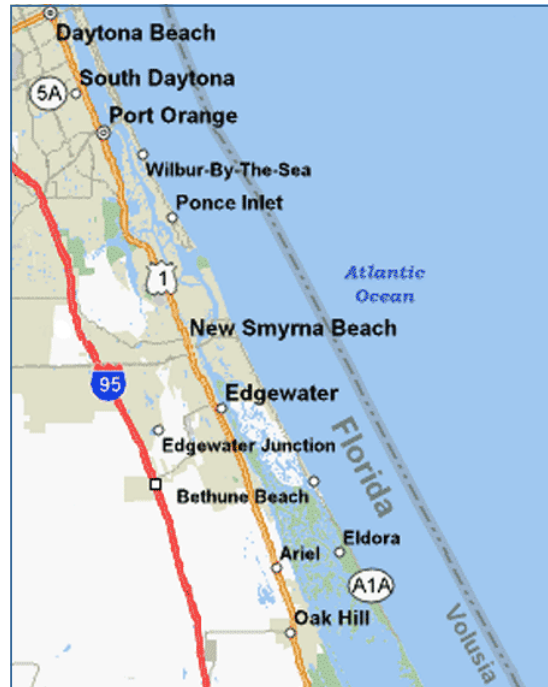
BACKGROUND

MOON PHASE: Waning Gibbous, 79% of the moon's visible disk was illuminated. Full Moon, September 26, 1999.

SEA CONDITIONS: The water was turbid

DEPTH OF WATER: Two feet

TIME: 18h45



NARRATIVE: Joel Borges had been surfing but was walking to shore. He wasn't certain if he stepped on the shark. No other people were within 50 feet of Borges.

INJURY: The surfer's sustained three one-inch lacerations across the bottom of his right foot.
