

ACTIVITY: Body boarding

CASE: [GSAF 1999.10.30.b](#)

DATE: Saturday October 30, 1999

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean 300 yards south of the Main Street Pier in Daytona Beach, Volusia County, Florida, USA.

29.2°N, 81.0°W

NAME: Keven Dolsky

DESCRIPTION: He is a 45-year-old male from Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He was wearing dark-colored medium-length bathing shorts and using a plastic white-bottomed body board.

BACKGROUND

MOON PHASE: Waning Gibbous, 61% of the Moon's visible disk was illuminated. Last Quarter, October 31, 1999.

SEA CONDITIONS: The water was turbid.

DEPTH OF WATER: Four to five feet.

TIME: 17h30

NARRATIVE: Keven Dolsky was riding a wave on a body board when he felt something hit his right foot and brush against his right leg. He describes a slight tug on his foot but did not see anything in the water.

INJURY: He sustained three lacerations, each approximately 3/4" long, to the right foot.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: Unknown

SPECIES INVOLVED: Not identified. The shark was not seen.
