**DATE:** Tuesday November 30, 1999

**LOCATION:** The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean off Reef Road in Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, USA.

**NAME:** Jeremiah Wyche

**DESCRIPTION:** He is a 19-year-old male.

**BACKGROUND**

**WEATHER:** At 15h53 West Palm Beach recorded mostly cloudy skies and visibility of 10 miles. The air temperature was 72°F, dew point 53.1°F, humidity 51%, sea level pressure 30.22 inches, and wind direction was NNE at 21.9 mph.

**MOON PHASE:** Third (Last) Quarter, November 29, 1999

**ENVIRONMENT:** Baitfish were in the immediate vicinity.

**TIME:** 15h30

**NARRATIVE:** The surfer was paddling in white water when he was bitten.

**INJURY:** Lacerations to hand and wrist

**SPECIES INVOLVED:** Not identified, possibly a bull or spinner shark.
