

ACTIVITY: Killing sharks

CASE: GSAF 2003.04.26

DATE: Friday April 26, 2003

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean at Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. 22°54'S, 43°14'W

NAME: Unknown

DESCRIPTION: He is a Brazilian male.

BACKGROUND

MOON PHASE: New Moon, May 1, 2003

NARRATIVE: Following the two minor injuries sustained by people at Copacabana Beach, some members of the public attempted to kill every shark they could find, and at least one man was nipped by a shark.

INJURY: The man sustained shallow lacerations to his left thigh.

NOTE: This is a provoked incident.
