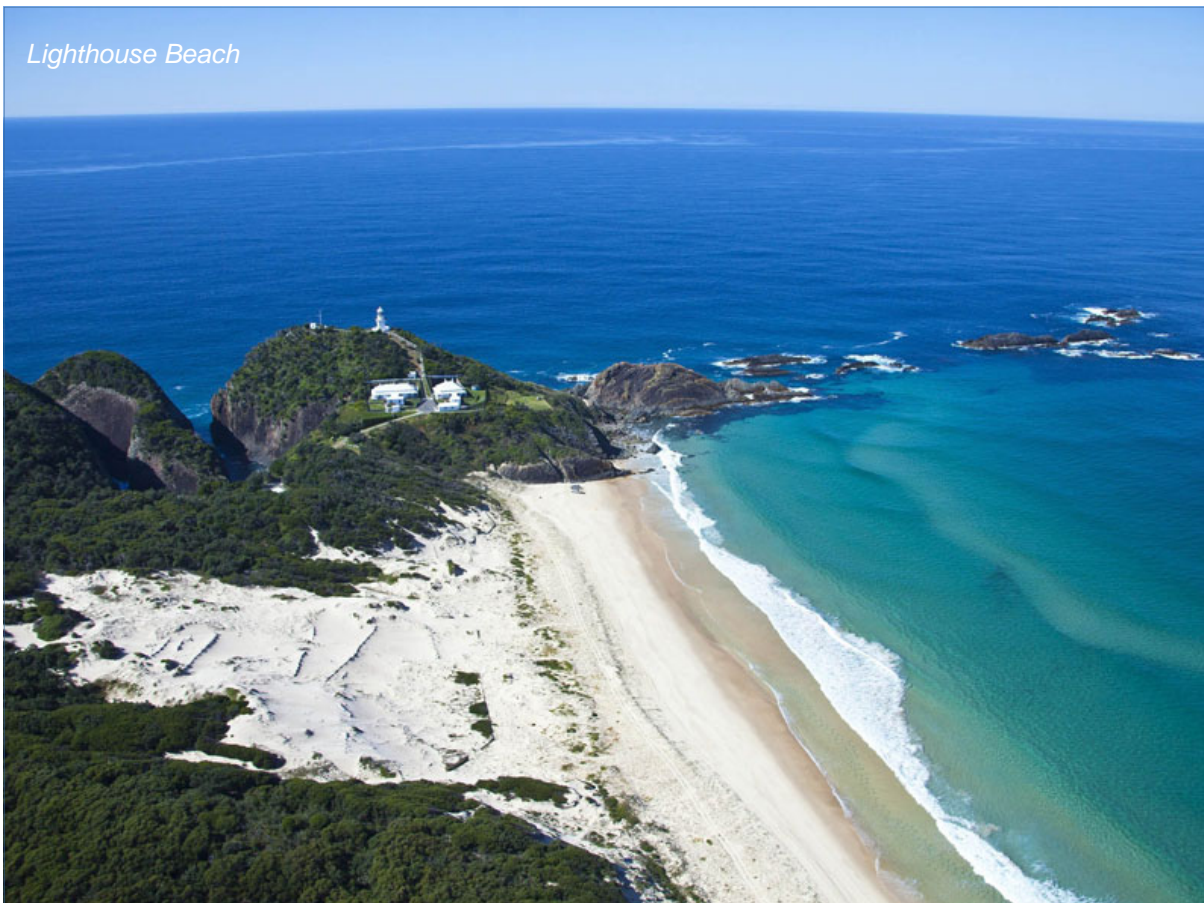


Lighthouse Beach
