CASE: GSAF 2007.03.31.a

DATE: Saturday March 31, 2007

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean at Waveland Park*, Fort Pierce, St Lucie County, Florida, USA.

NAME: Unknown

DESCRIPTION: He is a nine-year-old male.

BACKGROUND

WEATHER: The air temperature was 72°F [22.2°C], dew point 56°F [13°C], humidity 59%, sea level pressure 30.08 inches [1018.5 hPa], and there was no precipitation.

MOON PHASE: Waxing Gibbous, 97% of the Moon's visible disk was illuminated.

SEA TEMPERATURE: 77 F [25°C].

TIME: 13h21

NARRATIVE: No details.

INJURY: The boy was bitten in the right buttocks and upper leg.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: Witnesses took the boy to a local a nearby Cumberland Farms convenience store in the 10900 block of South Ocean Drive, where 911 was called. Paramedics arrived and transported him by ambulance to Martin Medical Center.

He was taken by ambulance to Martin Memorial Medical Center, where he was treated and released.
