**ENVIRONMENT:** Lovers Key State Park, located between on County Road 865 between Bonita Beach and Fort Myers Beach, consists of four barrier islands. A haven for wildlife, the islands and their waters are home to West Indian manatees, bottlenose dolphins, roseate spoonbills, marsh rabbits, and bald eagles. The two mile long beach is accessible by boardwalk or tram and is popular for shelling, swimming, picnicking, and sunbathing.
