CASE: GSAF 2008.07.24.b

DATE: Thursday July 24, 2008

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean near Broadway Street, Surf City, Pender County, North Carolina, USA.

NAME: Jake Martin

DESCRIPTION: He is a nine-year-old male.

BACKGROUND

MOON PHASE: Last Quarter, July 25, 2008

TIME: Morning or early afternoon



NARRATIVE: Few details. Auxiliary Officer Beaver of the Surf City Police Department was stopped on the beach by the parent's of the boy who reported the incident to him. Officer Beaver contacted Officer Art Cunio who arrived onsite. The boy's father told the officers that he saw the shark at his son's foot, and picked the animal up. No further information was documented on this incident. Officer Cunio did not know the time of the incident.

INJURY: The injury consisted of very minor cuts, almost like scratches, on the boy's toe.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: Unknown. The officer did not know if the boy was taken to a hospital for further treatment.

SPECIES: Not identified, but according to the boy's father the shark was about three feet in length.
