

**ACTIVITY:** Air disaster

**CASE:** **GSAF 2009.02.08**

**DATE:** Sunday February 8, 2009

**LOCATION:** The accident took place in the Caribbean Sea off Quebradillas, Puerto Rico, USA

**NAME:** Unknown

**NARRATIVE:** A single engine Cessna 206 airplane, enroute from the Dominican Republic, crashed into the ocean. All five passengers and the pilot were apparently killed on impact. One man's body was recovered.

**INJURY:** It is probable that the man died when the plane hit the water and his body subsequently scavenged by a shark or sharks.
