LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean near the Zelda Beach Approach at Daytona Beach, Volusia County, Florida, USA.

BACKGROUND

WEATHER: At 15h53, Daytona Beach recorded overcast skies and visibility of 10 miles. The air temperature was 91°F, dew point 70°F, humidity 50%, sea level pressure 29.96 and wind direction was WSW at 8.1 mph.

MOON PHASE: Full Moon, July 7, 2009

SEA CONDITIONS: The sea was murky.

ENVIRONMENT: Baitfish were in the area.

DEPTH OF WATER: Four feet

TIME: 16h00

NARRATIVE: No details

INJURY: The girl's right ankle was bitten.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: The girl's parents drove her to a hospital, where she received stitches for her wound.

SPECIES: Thought to involve a juvenile blacktip shark.
