NAME: Deacon Plant.

NARRATIVE: Deacon Plant was spearfishing with a friend when they spotted the shark. "We were only in the water for 20 minutes when it started to circle us," he said. "It circled and then dived down to the bottom. It came back up and literally head-butted my thigh and really spun me around."

The pair headed for shore but were followed by the shark. "We had to get out of there but, as we got closer to the rocks, the shark circled my mate a few more times," Plant said.

INJURY: Neither diver was injured by the shark.

SPECIES: Not identified. According to Plant, the shark was almost four metres in length.
