

ACTIVITY: Surfing

CASE: GSAF 2011.05.13.a

DATE: Friday May 13, 2011

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean near the Harvard Drive beach approach in Ormond Beach, Volusia County, Florida, USA.

NAME: Adrian Bronson

DESCRIPTION: He is a 37-year-old male.



BACKGROUND

WEATHER: At 06h50 Ormond Beach recorded clear skies and visibility of 10 miles. The air temperature was 69.8 F, dew point 66.2°F, humidity 88%, sea level pressure 29.95 inches and there was no wind.

MOON PHASE: Waxing Gibbous, 80% of the Moon was illuminated. Full Moon, May 17, 2011.

SEA CONDITIONS: At Trident Pier the sea surface temperature was 80.1°F, at Mayport (Bar Pilots Dock), FL it was 75.9 F, and at Ormond Beach, 72° to 74°F.

DEPTH: "Shallow water"

TIME: 06h30 (Sunrise at 06h33)

NARRATIVE: No details

INJURY: He sustained minor puncture wounds to his calf.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: Hospitalization was not necessary. After surfing, Mr. Bronson went to work according to Volusia County Beach Patrol Capt. Tammy Marris.
