



ACTIVITY: Wade fishing

DATE: Monday July 25, 2011

LOCATION: The incident took place in the bay at Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey, USA.

NAME: Eric Aubrey

DESCRIPTION: He was wearing neoprene waders, waterproof trousers worn by surf fishermen.

BACKGROUND

DEPTH OF WATER: Waist-deep

TIME: Night

NARRATIVE: Eric Aubrey and Ryan Sherwood were fishing trying to catch some striped bass or bluefish, when Aubrey felt pressure on his left leg and pulled his leg away. Once out of the water the men saw what they believe were teethmarks on Aubrey's waders.

INJURY: No injury.

SPECIES: Not identified. The fishermen speculated the incident may have involved a sandtiger shark or a brown shark (sandbar shark)
