NAME: Unknown

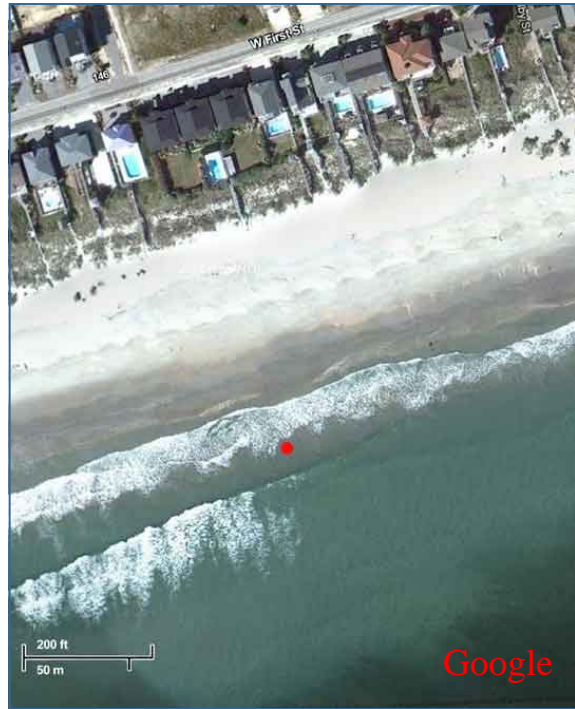
DESCRIPTION: He is a 12-year-old male.

WEATHER: At 11h53, North Myrtle Beach recorded clear skies and 10-mile visibility. The air temperature was 90°F (heat index 99°F, dew point 73.9°F, humidity 59%, sea level pressure 30.16 inches (falling) and wind direction was variable at 3.5 mph.

MOON PHASE: Waxing Crescent, 21% of the Moon was illuminated. First Quarter, July 26, 2012.

TIME: Around 11h45
