**ENVIRONMENT:** The incident took place in an area where fishermen waded in several feet of water to go bone fishing.

**DEPTH OF WATER:** Knee deep

**NARRATIVE:** Kerry Anderson was fly fishing, standing in the water, when he saw the shark's fin. He says the shark came straight at him and grabbed his foot.

**INJURY:** His left foot was bitten.

**FIRST AID / TREATMENT:** The fisherman went to a local clinic on his own, then he was airlifted to a hospital in Nassau for treatment.

**SPECIES:** Not identified, but bull and tiger sharks are seen in the area.
