BACKGROUND

DEPTH OF WATER: Waist-deep

TIME: Afternoon

NARRATIVE: The girl was boogie boarding with her stepfather when she was bitten by the shark. She screamed and ran from the water. Eyewitnesses who saw the commotion said they quickly exited the water until it was deemed safe to return.

INJURY: There were teeth marks in the girl's left hand.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: A lifeguard wrapped the patient's arm to control the bleeding. According to authorities, the child only suffered minor wounds. She was taken to Grand Strand Regional Medical Center for treatment.

SPECIES: The girl said the shark was about four to five feet in length.
