



ACTIVITY: Fishing

CASE: **GSAF 2013.06.30**

DATE: Sunday June 30, 2013

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Pacific Ocean off Taitung County in eastern Taiwan.

NAME: Unknown

DESCRIPTION: He is a Taiwanese fisherman, one of the crew of the Kaohsiung fishing boat *Sheng Ji Cheng* (勝吉政號).

NARRATIVE: No details

INJURY: His right thigh was bitten by a shark and he suffered severe blood loss.

TREATMENT: The Chiayi Air Force Base was notified at 02h05 and dispatched an S-70C-6 "Seagull" rescue helicopter. Because the boat was beyond its flying distance, the helicopter had to land in Taitung to replenish fuel, and eventually reached the scene at 05h21. The patient was initially transported to Mackay Memorial Hospital in Taichung, and subsequently transferred to the Kaohsiung Chang Gung Hospital by ambulance.
