



ACTIVITY: Surfing

DATE: Tuesday April 15, 2014

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean at New Smyrna Beach, Volusia County, Florida, USA.

NAME: Unknown

DESCRIPTION: He is a 25-year-old male from Orlando.

BACKGROUND

WEATHER: At 09h00 the sky was partly cloudy with a fresh offshore southwesterly breeze.

MOON PHASE: Full, 99% of the Moon was illuminated.

SEA CONDITIONS: The sea surface temperature was 72°F, surf was 1 to 2 feet in height, swells were two feet at 9.4 seconds and mean high tide was at 09h00.

ENVIRONMENT: The area south of the jetty is a nursery for shark pups.

DEPTH OF WATER: Knee-deep

TIME: 09h57

NARRATIVE: The man was surfing near the jetty at Smyrna Dunes Park when he was bitten.

INJURY: The surfer sustained minor cuts to his left foot.

TREATMENT: The man did not go to the hospital
