



ACTIVITY: Swimming

DATE: Wednesday July 16, 2014

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Pacific Ocean off Paia, Maui, Hawaii, USA.

NAME: Unknown

DESCRIPTION: He is a 61-year-old male.

BACKGROUND

SEA CONDITIONS: The water was clear.

DISTANCE FROM SHORE: 200 yards

DEPTH OF WATER: 15 to 20 feet

TIME: 17h20. Firefighters were notified at 17h57

NARRATIVE: No details.

INJURY: Firefighters reported the man had five or six lacerations to his left foot, with the longest being about 6 inches.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: The man swam to shore on his own and walked to the front of the Pāia Youth Center at 28 Hana Highway. Firefighters provided first aid and he was taken to Maui Memorial Medical Center in stable, non-life-threatening condition,

SPECIES: Not identified. The man described the shark that bit him as gray-colored and six to eight feet in length.
