DATE: Saturday November 8, 2014

LOCATION: The incident took place in the Atlantic Ocean at Fort Pierce Inlet State Park, St. Lucie County, Florida, USA.

BACKGROUND

WEATHER: At 16h53, Fort Pierce recorded mostly cloudy skies and 10-mile visibility. The air temperature was 75.9°F, dew point 66°F, humidity 71%, sea level pressure 29.85 inches, and wind direction was SE at 8.1 mph.

MOON PHASE: Waning Gibbous, 96% of the Moon was illuminated.

SEA CONDITIONS: Mean low tide at Fort Pierce Inlet occurred at 15h06.

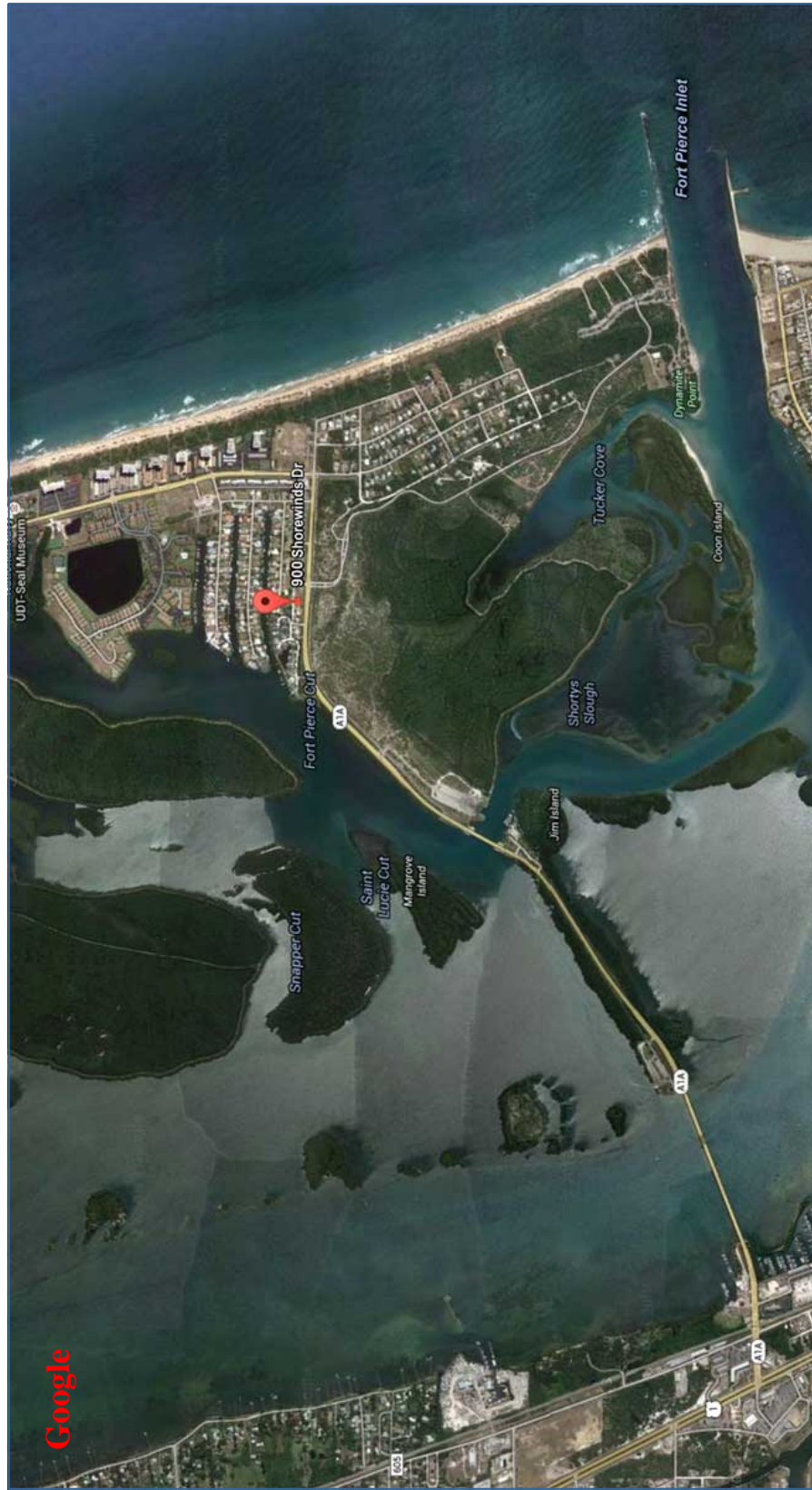
ENVIRONMENT: Fort Pierce Inlet State Park is located just north of the Fort Pierce Inlet, on North Hutchinson Island, near Fort Pierce.

TIME: 16h30 (Sunset at 17h320)

INJURY: Minor injuries to arm and hand.

TREATMENT: St. Lucie County Fire District Chief said the man met rescue workers at the 900 block of Shorewinds Drive and was transported to a local hospital.
