BACKGROUND

NARRATIVE: Albino Ernesto was fishing for shrimp, trying to land his full net, when the shark knocked him off his feet. The fisherman kept hold of his net and as the shark was attempting to make off with his catch it bit the man's arms. After a few seconds of struggle the fisherman, badly injured, managed to get lose from the shark's jaws.

INJURY: Both arms severely injured.

FIRST AID / TREATMENT: The patient was rushed to the Chicuque Rural Hospital in Maxixe, where the medical team saw no option but to surgically amputate both his arms. The next day hospital sources reported that his condition was stable.
