WEATHER: At 13h30, Brisbane (51 km west of North Stradbroke Island) recorded mostly cloudy skies and 6.2-mile visibility. The air temperature was 80.6°F, heat index 83.2°F, dew point 68°F, humidity 65%, sea level pressure 29.77 inches (falling) and wind direction was SE at 11.5 mph.

MOON PHASE: Waning Crescent, 15% of the Moon was illuminated. New Moon, February 9, 2016.

SEA CONDITIONS: The sea surface temperature was 80°F, estimated.

DEPTH OF WATER: Shallow

TIME: 13h20

NARRATIVE: No details

INJURY: Nip to foot
