WEATHER: At 13h47, New Smyrna Beach Municipal Airport recorded 10 miles visibility and scattered clouds. The air temperature was 86°F, heat index 96.9°F, dew point 77°F, humidity 74%, sea level pressure 29.99 inches and wind direction was East at 20.7 mph.

MOON PHASE: Waning Crescent, 8% of the Moon was illuminated. New Moon, September 1, 2016.

TIME: 14h00

INJURY: The man sustained a minor bite to his ankle.

TREATMENT: He was not transported to the hospital, and said was going to have the injury looked at on his own.
