## **BACKGROUND**

MOON PHASE: Waning Gibbous, 95% of the Moon was Illuminated

ENVIRONMENT: Many marine predators from sport fish to sharks were feeding on the

annual mullet run moving through the area.

**TIME:** 11h00

**NARRATIVE:** This was the second of three shark bites within a three hour time span at the beach. Due to the added danger of shark attacks during the seasonal fish migration, signs warning of "dangerous marine life: had been posted at most beach entrances, but many surfers ignored the warning and continued paddling out to catch waves.

**INJURY:** Significant lacerations to both hands.

**TREATMENT:** The patient was transported to a hospital where he was admitted for surgical repair of his injuries.
